At Schooner Commons, we strive to cook with fresh, locally-sourced ingredients. Dining is offered to our guests all year by reservation.

Our talented and friendly staff at **Schooner Commons** prepare and serve three meals a day to guests with prior reservations. Bag lunches, private parties, and receptions are available options. Our standard meal service is **cafeteria-style**, but our talented team can cater events from small **happy hours**, plated **dinner parties**, buffet **brunch** or lunch, **lobster bakes**, and large **receptions** - just ask!

Soups, dressings, sauces, and baked goods are prepared from scratch daily. In addition to a "chef's choice" hot entree, guests at lunch and dinner are invited to prepare their own salad from our robust salad bar furnished with fresh vegetables and hearty proteins. We can accomodate groups of up to **124 people**.

We offer a wide selection of lodging options inside Acadia National Park, so you can find the perfect fit for your group or event.

Schoodic Shores: Located in a village-like setting, these apartment-style townhouses are a perfect choice for groups of mixed ages.

Bunkhouse: An ideal option for larger groups (think students, teachers, and chaperons under one roof), this dormitory-style housing facility can accommodate up to 71 guests and hosts roughly 1,000 students each year.

Duplex Cabins: Nestled in a quiet, wooded area of our campus are Cape Cod-style cabins. Also available are four, one bedroom efficiency units, each with a private bedroom with one full size bed.

Rockefeller Hall Apartments: Designed by John D. Rockefeller's personal architect Grosvenor Atterbury and built in the 1930s, these executive apartments each represent a different National Park. Guests can enjoy a beautiful shared terrace with an ocean view on the first floor.


